YOUTH SERVICE CAMP

We have seven young people who will be attending the Youth Service Camp in St. Petersburg at the cathedral for 5 days in August. This is the first time our young people have taken part in mission work.

They will be joined by about 90 Lakota youth from the Tree-of-Life Rosebud Reservation. This is an exchange program. Last year young people from our diocese did mission work on their reservation with them. They will live at FL Resurrection House, part of the cathedral complex, and do service projects in the area.
