## **God's Incredible Blessings**

The Narthex project was completed at a total cost of \$181,525.87. You will recall that we borrowed \$107, 000.00 from the Diocese at 3%. \$70,333.19 was used to pay off the old mortgage on Krysher Hall. The remaining \$36,666,81 was used for the Narthex project, with the remaining \$144,859.06 coming from donations from the congregation. Interestingly, the total owed to the Diocese on that loan, as of December 31, 2016 is \$79,639.73, only \$9,300.00 over the amount owed on the old mortgage.

## **Bereavement Ministry**




Our Bereavement Ministry provides comfort to members of our parish who have suffered the lost of a loved one. This ministry puts together a reception for those who fall into this category.


